In addition to our overnight camps, we are excited to offer the following day camps:

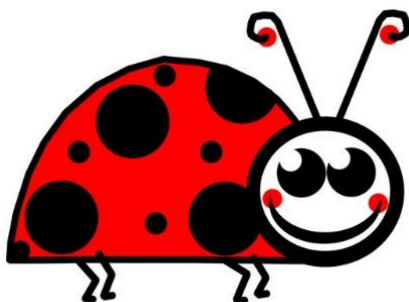


Farm to Fork Camp 2018 – This is a day camp program for ages 9 and up. We will explore all things food including a “Farm to Table” component so participants can truly see where our food comes from. This will also include field trips to local farms, working in our on-site garden, and other interactive activities to go along with this theme. It will incorporate cooking while learning about nutrition and food science. This camp is planned for June 12-14 from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. each day. Cost is \$35 for materials, snacks, and transportation. Space is limited.



Bug Fest Day Camp- We are planning a day camp this summer on July 24th – July 26th. It will be

from 9am – 1pm and held here at the Prince Edward Extension Office. It is for ages 9 and above. We will be outside discovering all the “critters” that live around us. There will be several “mini” field trips around our area to get a better idea of insects that live around us. We will focus on discovery and identification. The cost for this camp will be \$10 to cover materials. This camp will be a prelude to the “Hokie Bugfest” held in the fall each year at Virginia Tech.
